Judgment related to Automotive Parts Plea Agreement with DOJ

[Aichi, Japan] Omron Automotive Electronics Co. Ltd. ("OAE") entered into a Plea Agreement with the United States Department of Justice ("DOJ") on March 16, 2016, to resolve allegations that OAE violated US antitrust laws in connection with the sale of power window switches to one customer and agreed to pay a fine of 4.55 Million USD. On June 13, the Eastern District Court of Michigan entered a judgment on the case and ordered OAE to pay the 4.55 Million USD fine within 15 days of entry of judgment as described in the Plea Agreement.
